



JUNIOR POLICE ACADEMY APPLICATION

The Kearny Police Department's Community Policing Unit is holding its annual Junior Police Academy for qualified boys and girls ages 11 through 13.

This program will be held at Lincoln School from July 29, 2024 – August 8, 2024.

The objective of our Junior Police Academy program is to introduce cadets to the principles of law enforcement, instill a sense of responsibility and leadership, and provide them with foundational knowledge and skills related to public safety and community service through a fun and educational Police Academy format. The curriculum includes various presentations from guest law enforcement agencies, hands on practice and physical training in an effort to give the cadets an idea of what training is involved in becoming a Police Officer.

The daily schedule is approximately 8:30am to 3:30pm. Cadets are to arrive at Lincoln School no later than 8:30am. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. Please be prompt when dropping off and picking up the cadets.

It is not required that each cadet bring lunch, unless advised to do so. Cadets that choose to bring their own lunch **MUST** label all containers. Throughout the day, there will be breaks; snacks/drinks will be provided however cadets can bring their own if they wish.

There will be a \$60.00 fee for each cadet. The fee will cover miscellaneous expenses for the Junior Police Academy and Academy attire.

A Graduation ceremony will take place on August 8, 2024 at Lincoln Middle School. Each student will receive a certificate upon completion of the course.

Application forms must be completed and returned no later than the last day of school (June 21, 2024) **with a photo of the applicant. Applications can be submitted to the school main office or Kearny Police Headquarters.** All applications will be reviewed thoroughly, any/all missing parts of the application will result in an incomplete application and the applicant may be disqualified.
